The **Unit Committee** and the **Charter Partner** have the **responsibility to provide opportunities** for all Scouts to raise the necessary funds to participate in Scouting's many programs.

When family finances and unit money-earning opportunities cannot provide sufficient funds for Scouting fees, the Andrew Jackson Council has developed a fund that is available to help deserving Scouts. This money is raised through donations from individual, civic clubs, small business, corporations, foundations, and grants.

Please complete the following application, with the required signatures: **Parent/Guardian**, and either the **Unit Leader** (Cubmaster, Scoutmaster, Crew Advisor, or Skipper), **Committee Chair**, or the **Charter Organization Representative**.

The **Unit** (Pack, Troop, Crew, or Ship) is required to **actively participate** in the **Annual Popcorn Sale** and allow a **Family Friends of Scouting Presentation** at a parent event like a **Pack Meeting/Blue and Gold Banquet** or a **Court of Honor**.

The Andrew Jackson Council defines **actively participating** in the Popcorn Sale as the unit having a popcorn kernel, being registered to sell, attending the Popcorn Kick-off, and promoting and encouraging all Scouts and their families to participate in the sale.

The Scholarship is good through the **calendar year (January 1st - December 31st)**

SCHOLARSHIP FOR SUMMER/WINTER CAMPS and NYLT

For scholarships for Summer/Winter and NYLT, the early bird fees must be paid by the due date or the parent/guardian part increases accordingly. **Out of Council Units** may only apply for Summer Camp and Winter Camp only.

Any application that is not signed or completed will not be processed. Scholarships will be made up to **50% of the request**. Families must reapply every year. Families and unit leaders will be notified by email if the scholarship is approved.
